If there is more than one winner there will be a count back of the last four holes.

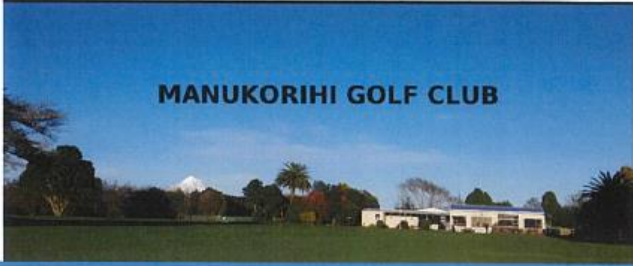
The draw will only commence once the last player has handed their card in.
