You can use the 18th fairway on course for hitting a Driver / 3 wood if safe to do so, **DO NOT HIT INTO THE GREEN.**

Anything else use the range please

YOU CAN NOT PRACTISE ON ANY OTHER PART OF THE COURSE INCLUDING PUTTING ON GREENS OR YOU WILL BE D.Q

NO EXCEPTIONS, SO PLEASE DON'T PUT US IN THAT SPOT.

You CAN NOT PLAY IN A TWO, must be a minimum of 3 players in a group.

You MUST TEE OFF THE FIRST.

You MUST COMPLETE ALL 3 ROUNDS TO BE IN FOR THE COMP.

Match play will use the best **two GROSS** scores from stroke **PLAY** to qualify you in the **MATCH** play top 16. So, the top 16 per division will be seeded for the match play which follows the stroke play comp. Unless there is an empty spot due to someone pulling out then the 17th qualifier will be asked join the top 16 and so on until the top 16 is found.
