### **Projects**

As always there continue to be a range of improvement projects on the go, both on and off the course, along with the usual course maintenance activities. Most of these projects require volunteer expertise and availability in order to minimise costs, and unfortunately two projects in particular have suffered delays as a result: the long-awaited upgrade of the women's amenities facilities, and the relocation of the Dotgolf terminal and card printer outside the clubhouse, allowing access when the clubhouse is closed. Pleasingly it is expected that both these projects will start shortly.

Renewal of our water resource consent from the Taranaki Regional Council has been granted at last, for a period of 15 years expiring on 1 June 2039.

We applied to the New Plymouth District Council for renewal of our bar licence and received that in August, for a period of two years.

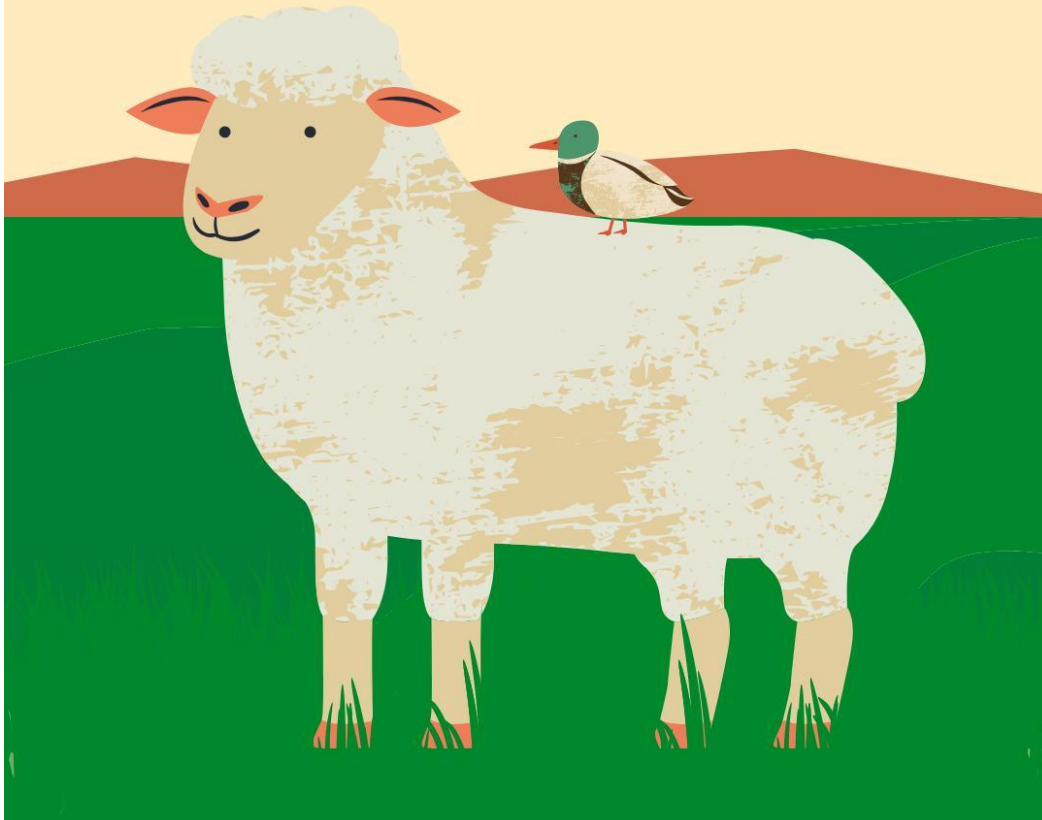
